Themed Run/Walk

Race day registration is available, but t-shirts are not guaranteed. Bib and t-shirt race packets are available on race day starting at 8 a.m.

Mile Fun Run/Walk: a shorter 1-mile path going partially around Ice Lake.

5K Fun Run/Walk: a 3.1 mile course looping through the Itasca County Fair Grounds.
